Staff Car Park

We would like to re-iterate that the school car park is for staff only.

Parents dropping off at breakfast club can enter the car park until 8.15am and the car park re-opens at 3.45pm. The only exceptions to this are parents with blue badges who have agreed permission following individual meetings held with them last term.

There are increasing numbers of cars attempting to gain access on the carpark at the start and end of school which is a danger to children and staff trying to enter/leave school.

Breakfast & After School Club

We would like to emphasise to all parents/guardians of children that use our breakfast and after school club facility the importance of paying the correct fees weekly/monthly in advance. If random payments are made then confusion is caused as to where you are up to with payments, so regular fixed payments rule out this confusion. Payments can be made either at the club or at the school office. If you do not have the correct money change will be sent home the same day. **Sessions should not be taken without payment in advance and will be suspended if payment is not received.**

Nursery Places

We currently have vacancies in our afternoon nursery for children who were 3 before 1st September. Any child who turned 3 after 1st Sept can still attend at a cost of £14 per session until they qualify for the 15 hours funding which is the term after their 3rd Birthday. If anyone is interested or knows of family members who may be, call into the office to collect an application form.
