Dinner Money & B/ASC Fees

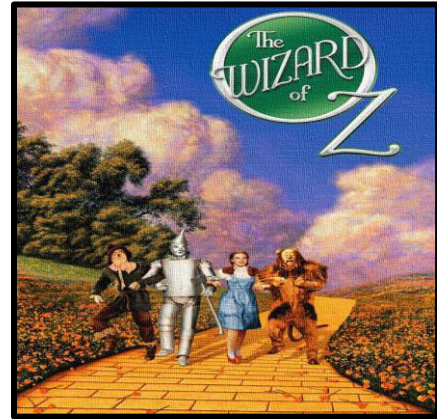
Can we please remind all parents/carers that payments for dinners and/or breakfast and after school club please be made on a Monday morning. This is imperative to secure your child's place in the club.
