On behalf of ALL staff here at Wargrave, we would like to wish All our parents and children a very Merry Christmas and a Happy & safe New Year.

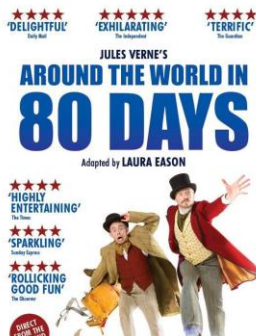
