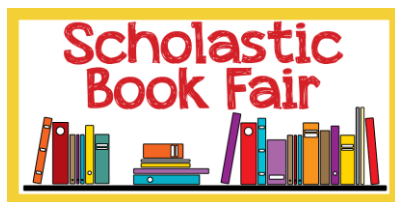
Congratulations must go to Miss Breeze who, in full costume, delighted the hall as Grandma from 'George's Marvellous Medicine' and was crowned this year's winner.
