Christmas Jumper Day

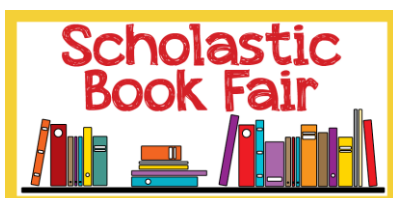
