Absences/Appointments


Our whole school attendance target is **96%**, if your child's attendance falls below this target due to regular non-attendance further absences may be un-authorised. In this instance school will require you to provide medical evidence before any absences are authorised. Please see information below.



Medical Evidence for Absences

If your child's absence has fallen below the school's attendance target you may be asked to provide medical evidence

School will accept the following items as medical evidence:

- A signed, dated appointment card. 
- A copy of a medical appointment letter
- Sight of any prescribed medicine (this must include the name of the child and the date issued)
- Signed and dated 'Care at the Chemist' evidence

If your child has any health issues please inform school of the condition and any prescribed medication so that we are aware and can support your child.
